Photography

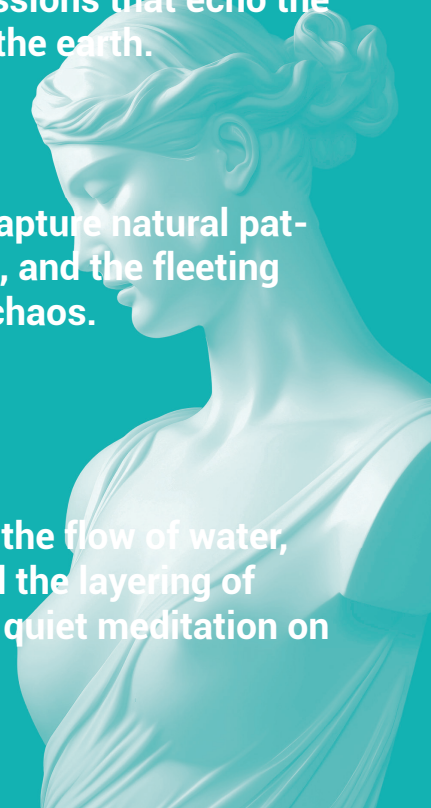
Stone, wood, and mixed media are transformed into poetic expressions that echo the geometry and rhythm of the earth.
